

Pre-Trip Checklist

Trout Camp

What to bring *(Remember, you are not the only one at camp. Try to pack light):*

WISCONSIN FISHING LICENSE w/ an INLAND TROUT STAMP IS REQUIRED.

- 3-5 wt rod w/ matching WF floating line. (rod rental fee: \$25/rod)
- Any flies you may have tied and would like to try.
- Waders and boots.
- Layers. (if you need help contact us)
- Polarized sunglasses.
- Water bottle. (we try to reduce our plastic use)
- Rain Jacket. (just in case)
- Headlamp.
- Off the water clothing.
- Footwear. (The tent does not have a closed floor, it is grass. A pair of soled moccasins or slip on shoe are great for in the tent)
- Toiletries.
- Camera.
- Camp Chair.
- Sleeping Bag, Pillow, and sleeping pad.* - (we will provide cots and tents)
- Snacks. (we provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- Beverages. (We'll have water, if you want something else, bring it. A fine Bourbon or Scotch is always welcome.)
- Speaker for tunes. (if desired)

*If you are opting for the cabin option you can omit this.

CRASH CAMP

WHAT TO BRING *(Remember, everything must come out by boat. Try to pack light):*

- 7-8 wt rod w/ matching WF floating line.
- Any flies you may have tied and would like to try. (see flies page)
- Wet wading clothes, quick drying (no cotton) Synthetic materials are best. Swimsuit works.
- Sun hat and lotion.
- Water shoes of some sort. (crocs, flats boots, keens, tevas, an old pair of sneekers, etc)
- Polarized sunglasses.
- Water bottle. (we try to reduce our plastic use)
- Light Jacket. (evenings can be cool)
- Rain Jacket & Pants. (just in case)
- Headlamp.
- Off the water clothing: a light pair of pants can be nice as bugs can be bothersome at sundown.
- Towel.
- Toiletries.
- Camera.
- Camp Chair.
- Bug spray. (nights)
- Sleeping Bag, Pillow, and sleeping pad. (we will provide cots and tents)
- Spinning Gear and necessary equipment. (if desired) - (We don't guide spin gear thus do not have the equipment)
- Water resistance duffel for your clothes and gear.
- Snacks. (we provide breakfast, lunch, and dinner)
- Beverages. (we'll have water, if you want something else bring it. **No Glass allowed on river**)

Gear

Lower Sconnie Smallmouth

- 7-8 wt rod paired with WF floating line.
- Any flies you may have tied.
- Wet wading clothes, quick drying (no cotton) Synthetic materials are best.
- Sun hat, buff, and lotion
- Water shoes of some sort (cros, keens, Texas, an old pair of sneakers, etc)
- Polarized sunglasses
- Water bottle (we try to reduce our plastic use)
- Rain Jacket
- Good attitude
- You are welcome to bring a few beers if you desire, please keep it within reason. **NO GLASS ALLOWED**



Driftless Trout

- 3-5 wt rod (if you have one, if not please let me know)
- Any flies you may have tied and would like to try.
- Breathable waders (Jan. – May) or Wet wading clothes (Ideal July-September), quick drying (no cotton) Synthetic materials are best.
- Sun hat, buff, and lotion
- Bug net (just in case)
- Buggins brand spray for gnats
- Polarized sunglasses
- Water bottle (we try to reduce our plastic use)
- Rain Jacket
- Good attitude
- You are welcome to bring a few beers if you desire, please keep it within reason.

Toothy Critters

- We provide rods setups (feel free to bring your own)
- 8-10 wt rod (pike)
- 10-12 wt rod (musky)
- Matching intermediate, sink tip, float lines (We generally like a type 3-5 sink/intermediate line)
- Any flies you want to try
- Waders & Boots(optional) - No cleats in boat.
- Rain gear
- Gloves
- Stocking cap
- Synthetic layers (cotton kills)
- Windproof layer
- Stripping guards
- Water bottle (we try to reduce our plastic use)
- Good Attitude
